### **Extending the consultation period on proposed changes to your tenancy**

We recently sent you information about proposed changes to your secure tenancy agreement. This information, known as the Preliminary Notice of Variation, explained the proposed changes and asked you for your comments.

We have had a number of requests from individual residents and tenants' and residents' associations to extend the deadline for responding to this information. As a result we have extended the deadline for you to send us your comments to **30 September 2008**.

#### **What do you need to do now?**

- **If you have already sent back your reply sheet** then you do not need to do anything. We will be contacting you again with the final version of the revised secure tenancy agreement once we have considered all your comments.
- **If you have not sent back your reply sheet yet**, we want to hear from you. You now have until **30 September 2008** to submit your comments.
