

**Role title:** Bricklaying Apprentice Level 2

**Site:** Fish Island Village

**Location:** Hackney Wick

**Purpose of role:**

To assist in Bricklaying work, carrying out duties and responsibilities in accordance with Health and Safety Regulations.

**Job Role**

- Work on a construction site to given specifications, setting out basic structures, building brick and block walling, laying domestic drainage, placing and finishing concrete and render surfaces
- Measuring the work area and setting out the first of bricks (courses) and damp course
- Mixing mortar by hand or with a mechanical mixer
- Laying the bricks on top of each other and applying the mortar with a trowel
- Shaping and trimming bricks using hammers, chisels and power tools
- Checking that courses are level using water or laser spirit levels
- Complete apprenticeship framework in line with individual learning plan
- The outlined duties may vary from time to time without materially changing either the character or level of responsibility

**Eligibility**

- Applicants are aged 18 and over
- Applicants must be eligible to work in the UK or E.U
- Good written and verbal communication skills, including the skill of listening and following both simple and complex instructions
- Minimum Level 2 in Functional Skills or GCSE grade C or above in English and Maths. (GCSE's valid within last 5 years)
